ENGLISH START SEPTEMBER FEBRUARY 1 YEAR THE HAGUE



This programme focuses on the causes of (perceived) threats to security, the political and social construction of (in)security, the pattern of reactions to these threats, prevention strategies and best practices. Crisis and security are studied from a multi-actor, multidisciplinary and multi-level approach. Crises and Security Management offers you the choice of four specialisations, each of which explores different themes from a crisis, terrorism and cybersecurity perspective.

The Executive Master's in Cyber Security is a multidisciplinary programme that focuses on the technological as well as the legal, administrative, economic and psychological aspects of digital security. The programme has been developed by Leiden University, Delft University of Technology, The Hague University of Applied Sciences and various private partners.

This Advanced programme is taught jointly by the Institute for Security and Global Affairs, the Institute for Political Science and the Netherlands Institute of International Relations Clingendael. This highly selective programme is a unique combination of academic education in international relations and political science, featuring practice-oriented courses and training in international negotiations and diplomacy. Each year, this programme attracts a large number of applications from students all around the world and the advantage of being in The Hague, the international city of peace and justice, is an additional asset.

Whereas the Governance and Consulting track takes off from a practice-oriented position and works towards analysis and reflection, the Politics, Policy, and Management track starts with academic analysis and reflection to work towards practical applications.

The central question within this master's is: how to address the world's most pressing policy challenges from a governance perspective? The Master's in Public Administration gives you a unique multi-level perspective on managing policy challenges in their complex societal setting where multiple actors, interests and policy areas intertwine. The three specialisations focus on an economic, international, and organisational approach of governance.
